RESOLUTION NO. 2016-05

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY DISPLAY
OF BANNERS**

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Lansdale in conjunction with the International Spring Festival (the "ISF") under the coordination of Mayor G. Andrew Szekely wishes to temporarily display banners that will portray various international countries and American flags on streetscape light poles within certain limits of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes for those banners to be displayed from approximately March 28, 2016 through April 30, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Lansdale as follows:

- 1) The Lansdale Borough Department of Public Works shall, upon request of the Borough Manager, install the banners subject to final review and approval of the content by the Lansdale Borough Manager and the Lansdale Assistant Borough Manager.
- 2) The ISF shall provide to the Borough a proof of each banner, in electronic format, prior to the production or display of any banner.
- 3) Lansdale Borough shall not be responsible for damage to the banners.
- 4) The banners shall be displayed, at the sole discretion of the Borough, beginning on or about March 28, 2016 through April 30, 2016.
- 5) The banners shall be hung over sidewalks and not roadways.
- 6) The banners shall be displayed, at the Borough's discretion, at the following locations:
 - a. A portion of West Main Street extending from Richardson Avenue to Broad Street.

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-06

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY DISPLAY
OF BANNERS**

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Lansdale in conjunction with and under the coordination of Ms. Anne Henning Scheuring (“Ms. Scheuring”) wishes to temporarily display banners that will portray Lansdale Borough Veterans “Hometown Heroes” on streetscape light poles within certain limits of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes for those banners to be displayed from approximately May 9, 2016 through November 14, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Lansdale as follows:

- 1) The Lansdale Borough Department of Public Works shall, upon request of the Borough Manager, install the banners in lots of twenty-five subject to final review and approval of the content by the Lansdale Borough Manager and the Lansdale Assistant Borough Manager.
- 2) Ms. Scheuring shall provide to the Borough a proof of each banner, in electronic format, prior to the production or display of any banner.
- 3) Lansdale Borough shall not be responsible for damage to the banners.
- 4) The banners shall be displayed, at the sole discretion of the Borough, beginning on or about May 9, 2016 through November 14, 2016.
- 5) The banners shall be hung over sidewalks and not roadways.
- 6) The banners shall be displayed, at the Borough’s discretion, at the following locations:
 - a. A portion of West Main Street extending from Richardson Avenue to Broad Street;
 - b. As more banners are purchased said banners may be displayed on certain portions of Broad Street as well as extending down East Main Street or extending down West Main Street toward Cannon Avenue.
