- Minutes from the February 1, 2017 Electric Committee Meeting were approved by a vote of 3-0.
- Committee Business Items
 1. G.I.S. Substation Inventory Upgrade – Mr. Krauss reported the GIS Department has worked to upgrade, update information, and make the substation map on our webpage user friendly. With over 3,000 views, this has been a great tool for both staff and the public.
 2. DVRPC LED Update – The Borough has finalized its bill of material and is ready to send JCI the notice to proceed. We hope to have material by April and start installation of the lamps at that time.
 3. NextEra Conference Update – Mr. Krauss reported that the presentation was a big hit at the Public Power Summit. Multiple municipalities have contacted both the electric and GIS departments for more information and feedback. NextEra is impressed with how far we have come and thankful that we were able to present.
 4. Green Light Go Grant Update – The project is moving forward with the first step being to correct existing issues at all the signals included under this project.
 5. Phase II Fiber Optic Progress – Phase II of the fiber ring has made significant progress with our goal being to complete this phase by the end of March.
 6. Irby Mobile Testing in March – Irby Electric Supply is now offering a mobile die-electric testing unit for line departments. On Thursday, as part of the Eastern PMEA Group, Lansdale will have all their protective rubber goods tested and replaced as needed onsite. This includes hot sticks, protective gloves, high voltage sleeves, line hose, rubber blankets, and deadend protectors.
