Minutes from the February 6, 2019 Public Works Committee Meeting were approved by a vote of 2-0.

o Committee Business Items

1. 2017 CDBG E. Third Street – Phase I (Chestnut Street to Ridge Street) – SJM Contractors started the curb and sidewalk work the week of February 25th but had to stop work due to the recent bad weather. They are still on schedule to complete this project on time.
2. Whites Road Rehabilitation – No requests for payment were submitted and the contractor doing the pipe lining started yesterday.
3. N. Line Street Rehabilitation – No requests for payment were submitted and there is nothing new to report.
4. 2018 Mill & Overlay Program – This item will be removed from the agenda until a further notice.
5. 2018 Microsurfacing Program – No requests for payment were submitted and there is nothing new to report.
6. W. Third Street Rehabilitation – No requests for payment were submitted and there is nothing new to report.
7. East Main Streetscape – There are no updates for this project at this time.
8. 2019 Mill & Overlay Program – We will be ready to advertise for bids this week and bids will be due in mid-April.
9. 2019 Microsurfacing Program – We will be ready to advertise for bids this week and bids will be due in mid-April.
10. 2019 N. Cannon Avenue Road Rehabilitation – We will be ready to advertise for bids this week and bids will be due in mid-April.
11. 2019 ADA Improvement Project – With last year's various road programs, we have identified getting the ADA ramps installed prior to the start of a proposed road project would help to alleviate some of the construction congestion. The borough would like to prepare and advertise bid specifications for ADA ramp construction as a separate contract. The committee voted 3-0 to put forth a motion to full council for approval to prepare and advertise this contract.

12. WWTP Updates

- a. Ridge Street Pump Station Upgrade – A payment request in the amount of \$17,138.80 has been received from Shainline for work completed on this project. This request has been approved by Bursich Associates, engineering consultant for this project. The committee recommended putting forth a motion to full council for approval of this payment.
 - b. Whites Road Sewer Line Rehabilitation – No request for payment was submitted and there is nothing new to report at this time.
- o Old Business – Mr. DeLong reported he received six quotes for the supply of a new dump truck and the cost came in as budgeted. The committee recommended putting forth a motion to full council to authorize the Borough Manager to purchase this vehicle under the PA Costars Purchasing Program.
 - o New Business – Mr. DeLong reported NPWA will be installing a new water main and services on North Wales Road between Berberry Drive and Sycamore Drive within the next few months. The County will be responsible for final paving of the roadway. The Borough has no work associated with this project and was mentioned for the committee's information only.
 - o Public Comment – A question was raised about the safety of the ADA ramps at both corners of Hancock Street at Church Road do to a street light pole and alignment issues. The engineer will be investigating this concern. Two residents questioned the condition of the intersection of Laurel Lane and Wissahickon Avenue. Mr. Fazio stated his firm is working on a drainage plan for this intersection and Mr. DeLong would fill the potholes as a short fix until more permanent work will take place.
