- Approval of Minutes from June 5 - The minutes were approved
- Committee Business Items
 - Budget Review 58% through the year. Revenues at 64% and Expenses at 51%. This year's Clean and Green event was the best ever for donations collected at \$1384 and 2nd best ever overall. 2013 was the best year.
 - Fall programming schedule – This fall, there will be some new programs at the library. There will be a discussion on Internet Safety, a discussion on how to fall safely geared towards seniors and children but useful for anyone. There will also be a discussion on the Making of the Modern Middle East by a retired professor from Montgomery County Community College on Tuesday evenings, Oct 8, 15, and 22.
 - Request for use of space outside – Reformation Lansdale would like to use some space outside to setup a table to give away King James bibles. We discussed guidelines for use of space outdoors covering location and number of times a group can request use. Tom will write up the policy and get back to this group.
- Old Business
 - CCAT Review scheduling - Tom will send out a Doodle Poll to council and schedule the review for the time that works best based on the poll.
 - Fire Alarm and Security System – Keystone came back with an estimate that is \$654 for install and \$590 annual to monitor fire alarms. Tom will discuss with them if the equipment will be compatible with any future plans.
 - Painting estimates – Sinn painting gave an estimate of \$4885 to paint the canopy of the front entrance. So far they are the only company willing to do the job. We will continue to try to get more estimates.
- New Business – We will plan to have a yard sale in October to go along with the 0.5K run.
