

## SEWER BILLING AGREEMENT WITH NORTH PENN WATER AUTHORITY

In March 2016, Borough Council voted to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with North Penn Water Authority (NPWA) for sewer billing services. What does this mean for you the resident? It means that you will now receive one combined bill for sewer and water usage. NPWA will issue a single bill to customers based off of usage collected and sent by the Borough. Customers will make payments to NPWA who will then remit the sewer portion to the Borough.

In addition to making it easier for customers to pay their bill, working

in conjunction with NPWA allows for a single point of contact for questions on billing or usage. This joint venture will also reduce redundancy in gathering information and in creating customer bills all while lowering costs for both organizations and ultimately you the customer.

NPWA is currently upgrading their billing software so that they are able to accept our usage data and create your bill. Once this process is complete, both the Borough and NPWA will meet to set a timeline for the process. As the schedule is confirmed, we will assure residents are aware when changes will begin to take place.

Spring is around the corner and the Code Enforcement Department wants to band together with the community and clean up our Borough! With recent improvements and ongoing development, the Borough encourages citizens to join us in Spring Cleaning efforts by cleaning up debris, weeds, curb lines in neighborhoods as well as by our businesses. The list below shows what you can do to help the Department of Code Enforcement in applying regulations and assist in your property maintenance.

- ◆ Make sure that grass and weeds grow no higher than six inches
- ◆ Place trash in approved and covered containers and check that it is picked up and disposed of properly
- ◆ Ensure all motor vehicles on your property have current registration; if they do not have proper stickers they should be parked in a garage
- ◆ Utilize the Spring Clean Up Dates May 2, 3, 5 & 6 to dispose of your yard materials properly
- ◆ Take advantage of the Borough's Yard Waste Drop Off every second Saturday from 7:00—11:00 am at Ninth Street and Moyers Road
